Postdoctoral position in experimental sleep research

at University Hospital (Inselspital) in Bern, Switzerland, Neurology Department

The University Hospital (Inselspital) in Bern, Switzerland, offers **from February 2012** a postdoctoral position in experimental sleep research. Our newly founded team investigates the role of sleep on functional recovery after focal brain damage and the involved neuroplasticity processes. We study in a rodent model of stroke the evolution of motor, cognitive and sleep-wake functions, as well as molecular pathways including the expression of neuroplasticity-related genes.

Applicants with a strong record in rodent sleep and/or molecular neurobiology will be considered. Experience in histological methods is also desirable. Successful applicants will be provided with start-up competitive funding upon joining the laboratory. The acquirement of own fundings is expected to occur within the first 2 years after appointment.
